### **Local Context**

Despite growth in the state's GDP and one of the highest rates of formal employment, 11% of youth face challenges in finding employment.

These young people may or may not be in school or at work, facing economic barriers such as poverty, lack of knowledge of and/or experience in the formal labor market, as well as limited access to quality education and job opportunities. They may also be affected by social factors such as gender inequality, disability, race, ethnicity, or migration.



























### **Training Model**

En Trayecto offers a short-term training model that combines technical training, life skills, and preparation for employment, as well as complementary support measures such as individual accompaniment and referrals to psychological support services, among others.

IYF draws on the philosophy of Positive Youth Development, which views young people as assets rather than 'problems to be solved," working for and with young people so that they are prepared to thrive in today's rapidly changing world of work.

### Over the course of 6 weeks, youth participants will receive:



### Technical

30 hours of courses offered by the Instituto de Apoyo al Desarrollo Tecnológico (INADET) and other institutions. We seek to offer training courses aligned with the current labor market in the state of Chihuahua, such as Lean Manufacturing and Programming.



#### Life Skills Training

20 hours using IYF's flagship Passport to Success® (PTS) program, facilitated by Grupo Re.



#### Job Readiness Workshop

5 hours addressing interview strategies, tips for a successful job search, building professional portfolios, and ensuring the availability of documents recessary for the job search.



#### Financial Education Workshop

2 hours of financial education, 1 hour taught by Citibanamer financial education volunteers, followed by another hour of reflection and resources provided by INADET.



# Complementary Activities and Special Events

3hours of activities to strengthen skills from day one, such as orientation sessions, integration activities, and a graduation ceremony.



#### Complementary Support Services

Tailored support to address individual needs and risk factors, ensuring a higher completion rate



### Young Graduates Community

Young Graduates Community: An online platform designed to provide access to job offers, scholarships, educational opportunities, and additional resources, facilitating job searches on platforms such as Linkedin and the National Employment Service.

This comprehensive approach seeks to prepare young people to meet the challenges of today's labor market and provide them with the tools they need to thrive in their career paths.
