Conectadas LAC provides training in technical and socio-emotional skills for 1100 young women in the Southeast region of Mexico and El Salvador to gain the confidence they need to enter and develop in ICT careers.

## **GENDER AWARENESS IN THE INDUSTRY**

In addition to the direct benefit to young women, Conectadas LAC seeks to:

- Raise awareness among their families, industry employers and civil society in general.
- Reduce gender-biased and culturally biased hiring practices.
- Generate a network of allies that encourage the participation of women in non-traditional areas.
- Increase women's labor participation in IT.

## **TARGET POPULATION:**

Young women aged 16-29 with an interest in ICT, prioritizing young women who have not completed a 4-year higher education program and/or high school graduates who lack opportunities to enter higher education, as well as participants who are unemployed or underemployed earning minimum wage.



## PROGRAM STRUCTURE AND COMPONENTS

The program is delivered virtually in groups of 25 to 35 participants and integrates training in technical, social-emotional, vocational and jobreadiness skills, as well as group integration activities, mentoring and role models.

## TECHNICAL EDUCATION

The program includes the Google IT Support Professional Certificate from Google Grow with Google, which has a technical curriculum path that is highly regarded in the technology industry and lasts for 12 weeks.

#### SOCIOEMOTIONAL TRAINING


Through the Passport to Success® program, beneficiaries develop life skills that are in high demand in the labor market. All within a positive and safe learning environment that encourages group reflection.

## COMPLEMENTARY ACTIVITIES

To ensure that the beneficiaries are prepared to enter the labor market, the program offers workshops on insertion and transition to a professional career.

#### MENTORSHIPS

To help the beneficiaries develop their confidence, define a clear career path and persevere through difficulties, among other personal and professional development issues, the beneficiary population will receive personalized support through mentors who act as positive role models.








