The Opportunity to Transform the Future

El Salvador's Information and Communication Technology (ICT) sector is growing steadily. Between 2018 and 2022, **employment in this sector increased by more than 6% annually, with over 5,179 new jobs created in 2022 alone.**

This dynamism offers a unique opportunity to strengthen local talent and reduce inclusion gaps in a strategic and high-demand sector. However, challenges persist, particularly for young women, who face significant barriers to accessing and thriving in technology careers.



Conectadas LAC, El Salvador: Closing Gaps and Creating Opportunities

In response to this challenge, the International Youth Foundation (IYF), with support from Google.org, launched the Conectadas LAC El Salvador program. This initiative aims to **close the gender gap in the ICT sector** by promoting the inclusion of young women aged 18 to 35 through technical training, socio-emotional skills development, and career guidance.

An Integrated Approach That Delivers Impact

Conectadas LAC El Salvador employs three key pillars to ensure participants' success:

Google Professional Certification

Provides training in IT Support, combining online learning with in-person sessions to develop high-demand technical skills.

Socio-Emotional Skills Development Through the Mi Carrera, Mi Futuro program and the Discover Your Vocation (DTV) platform, participants build life skills, receive career guidance, and enhance their adaptability to the job market.

Complementary Activities Includes workshops and additional resources to prepare participants for job searching, entry, and retention in the formal ICT sector.

With this holistic approach, Conectadas LAC El Salvador not only prepares participants for employment but also **fosters cultural change toward inclusion and gender equity in ICT.**

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Scaling the Impact

The program's success has paved the way for new initiatives. In 2024, with support from the National Training and Vocational Institute (INCAF), IYF, and the Ágape Association, 1,000 Salvadoran youth will receive training in technical and socio-emotional skills through the Google IT Certificate and the Mi Carrera, Mi Futuro component. This initiative will not only expand opportunities for young people but also establish El Salvador as a regional leader in tech talent development.
