For nearly 30 years, the International Youth Foundation (IYF®) has focused solely on helping young people succeed. A global nonprofit organization, IYF believes success in life is secured by learning skills that will endure, earning a livelihood, and growing as an engaged citizen. While most youth choose a career path and land that first job, many others decide to start their own small businesses or social ventures. - SOCIAL INNOVATION PROGRAMMING maximizes young civic leaders' impact and accelerates positive change in their communities.
