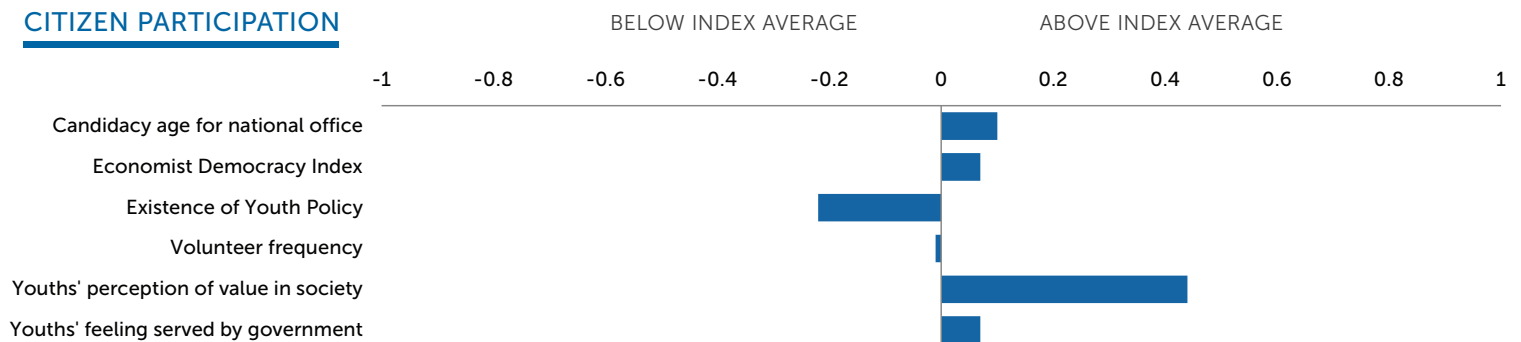

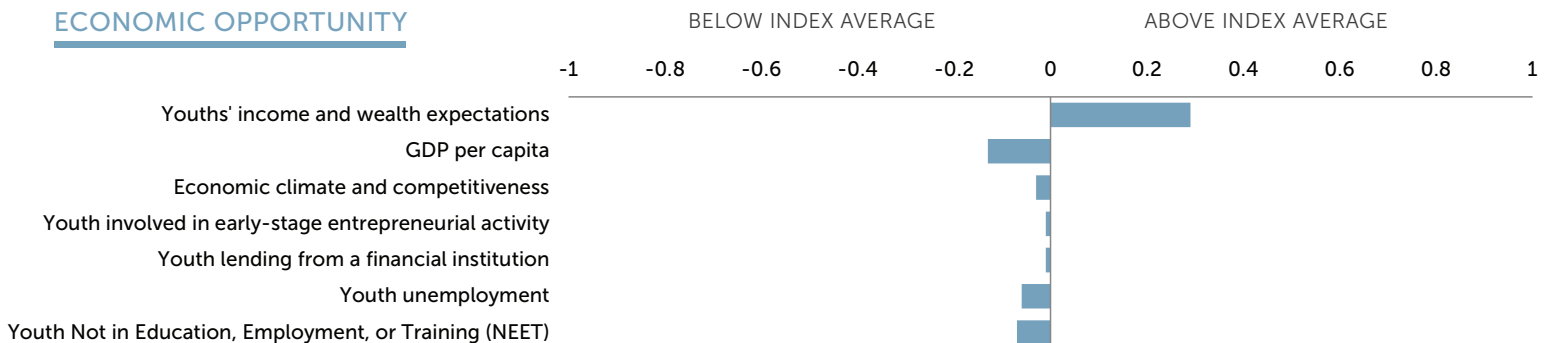

AT 19TH PLACE, INDONESIA ranks in the third of the four tiers for youth wellbeing along with other lower-middle income countries. Of the nine countries in the Asia-Pacific region, Indonesia is 6th followed by the Philippines and India. Generally youth report a positive outlook about their wellbeing, despite the challenges they face in their environment—challenges such as lower spending on public education and lower GDP per capita.

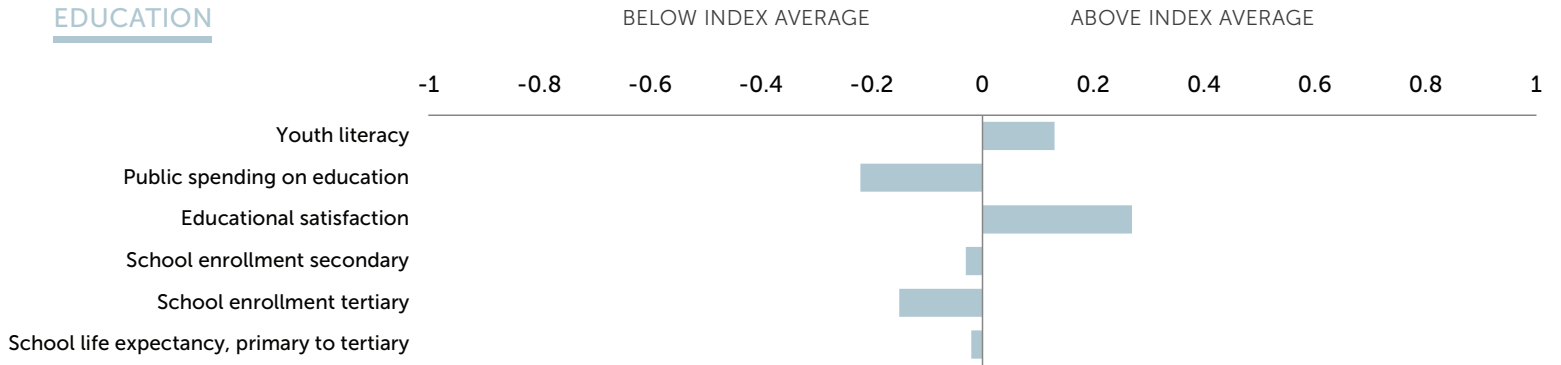
