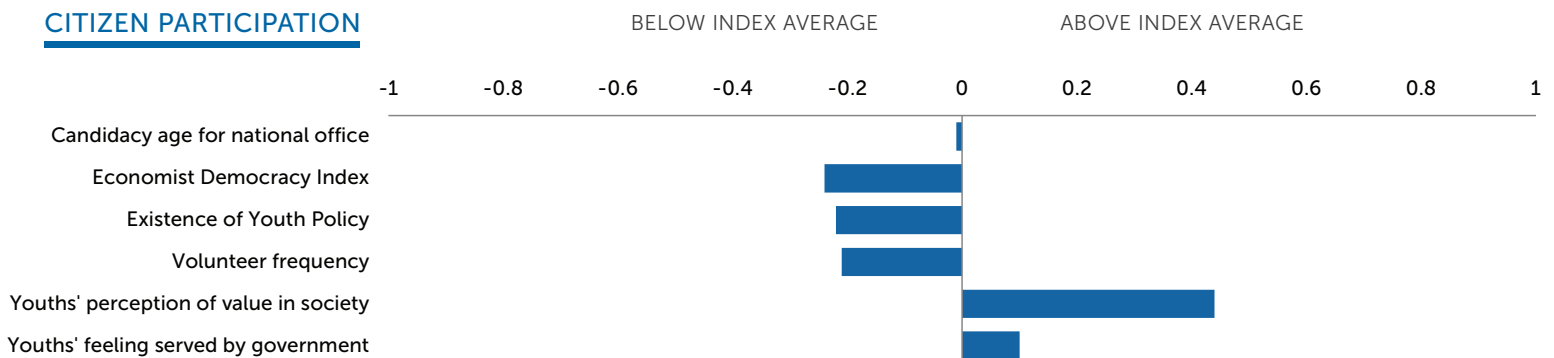

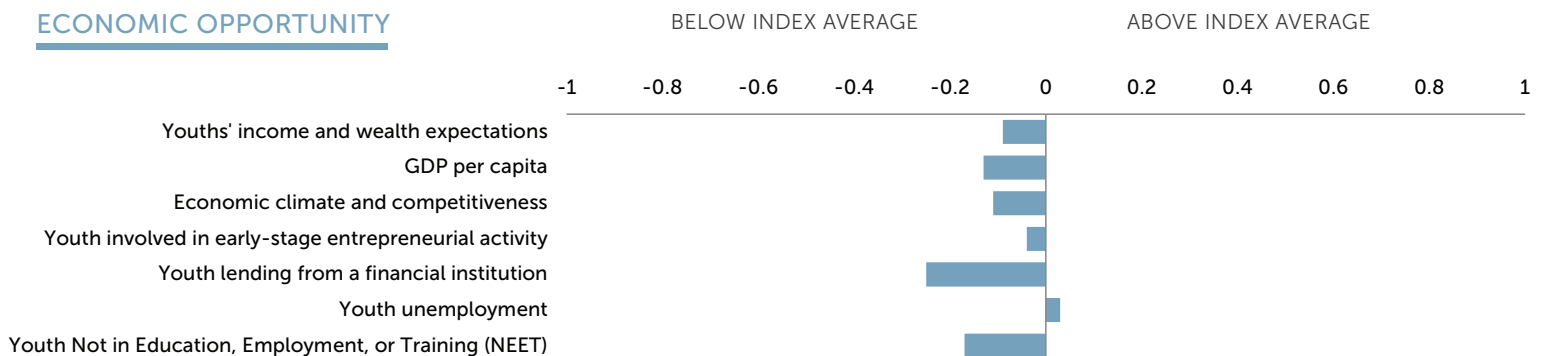
**Lower Middle**

AT 20TH PLACE OVERALL, MOROCCO'S score places it in the third of four tiers of youth wellbeing. Of the four countries in the Middle East-North Africa region, Morocco is third. Among the eight countries in the lower-middle income bracket, Morocco sits third behind Vietnam and Indonesia. Despite doing relatively well in three out of the six domains, Morocco achieves bottom tier rankings in the three remaining domains. Generally youths' levels of optimism vary in each domain, but they are more optimistic in citizen participation and health.
