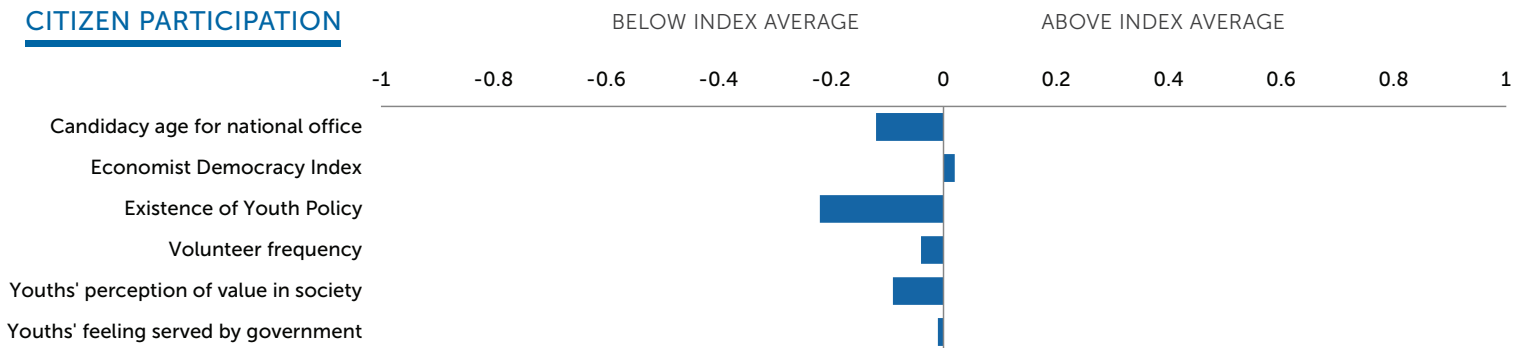

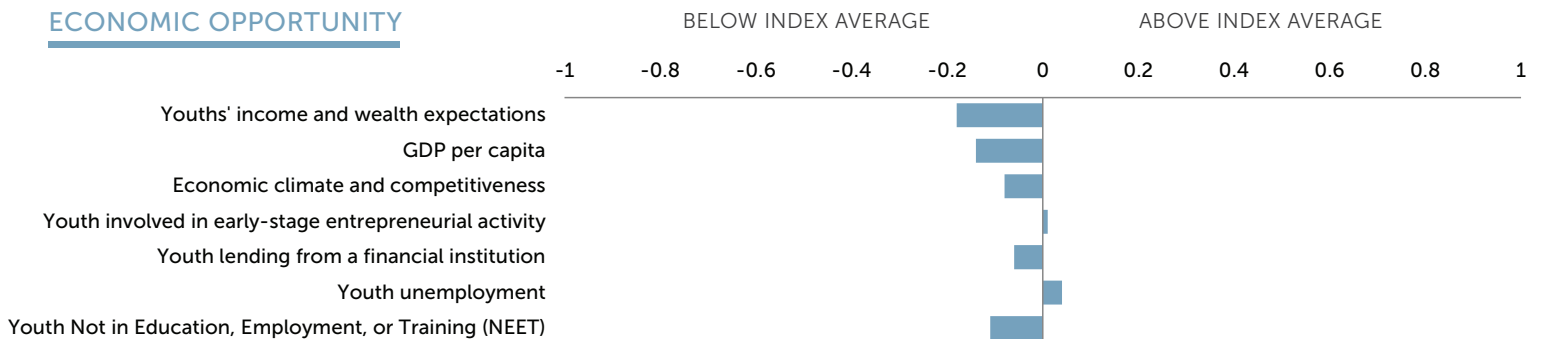

AT 22ND PLACE, THE PHILIPPINES places eighth among the nine countries in the Asia-Pacific region, and in the third of the four tiers of youth wellbeing. It also comes in fifth among the eight lower-middle income countries. With the exception of the education domain, weak youth outlook and satisfaction drives down the Philippines' scores across the domains. Filipino youth express their greatest dissatisfaction in safety and security.
