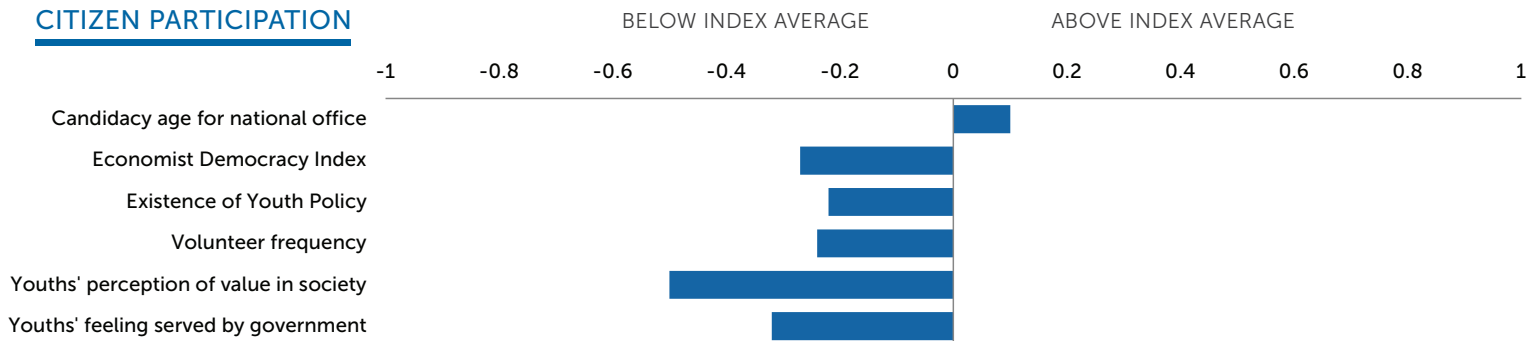

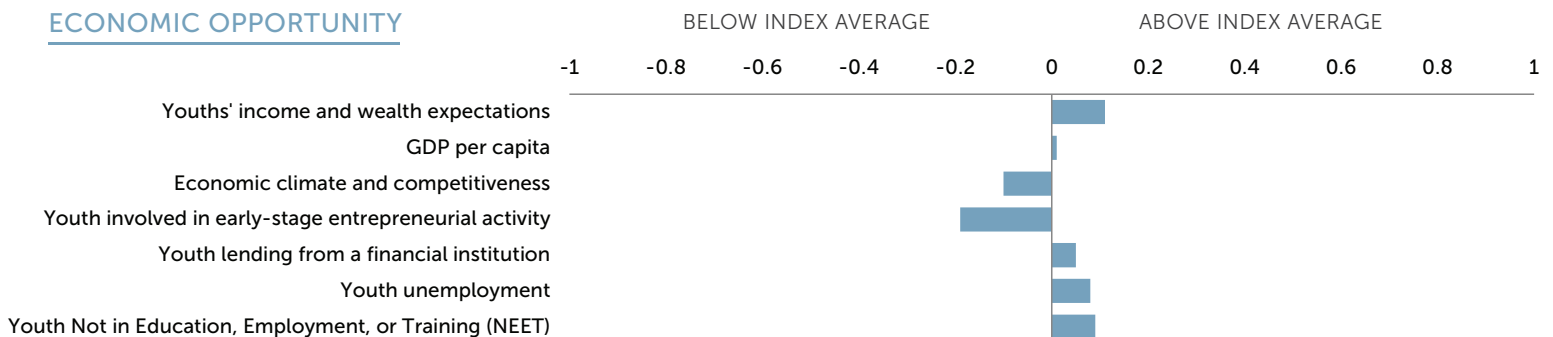

AT 25TH PLACE, RUSSIA ranks the lowest among high income countries placing in the last of four tiers of youth wellbeing. Russia's highest rankings are in the education and ICT domains, reflecting Russia's stronger infrastructure. However, youth are less optimistic and satisfied across the domains, with the exception of economic opportunity and ICT.
