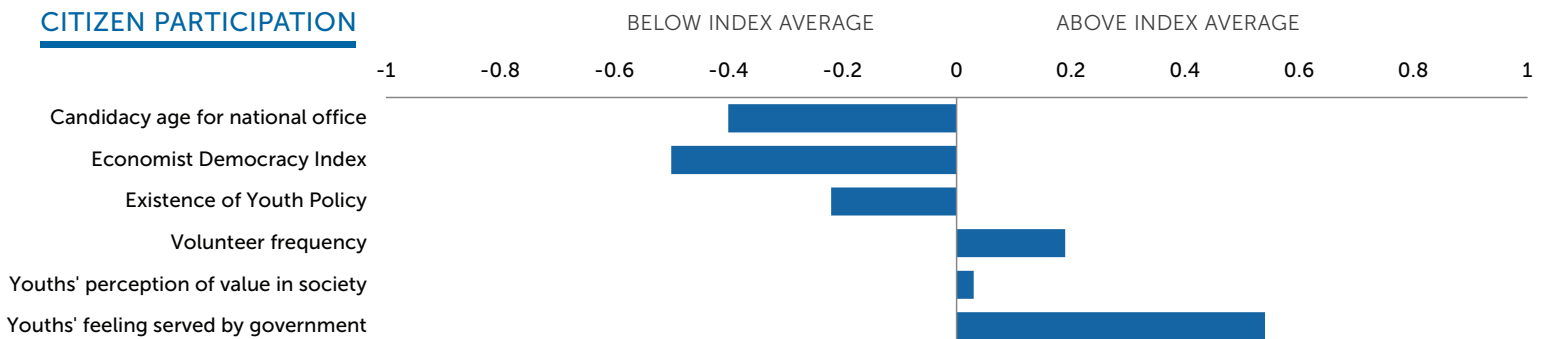

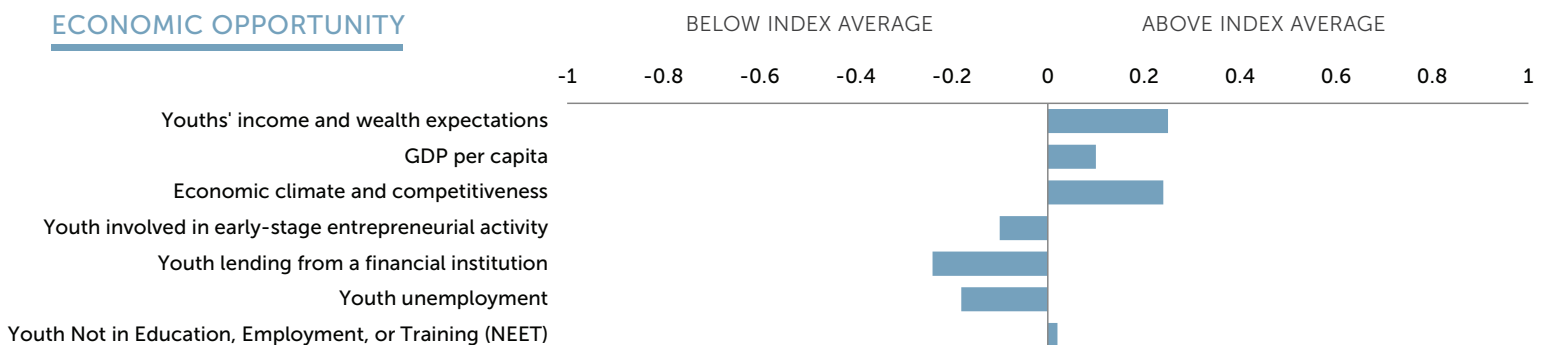

AT 9TH PLACE, SAUDI ARABIA is the first of the four countries in the Middle East-North Africa region, and places within the second of the four tiers of youth wellbeing. Saudi Arabia also ranks among the top ten countries, alongside its high income peers. Among the Middle East-North Africa countries, Saudi Arabia achieves the highest rankings in economic opportunity, education, health, and ICT. Across domains, youth are generally optimistic about their current status and future prospects.
