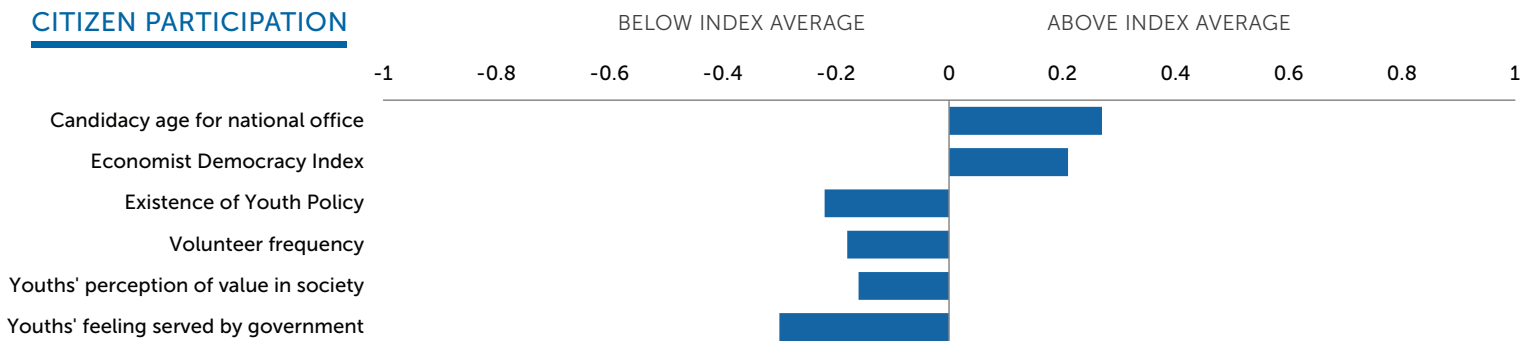

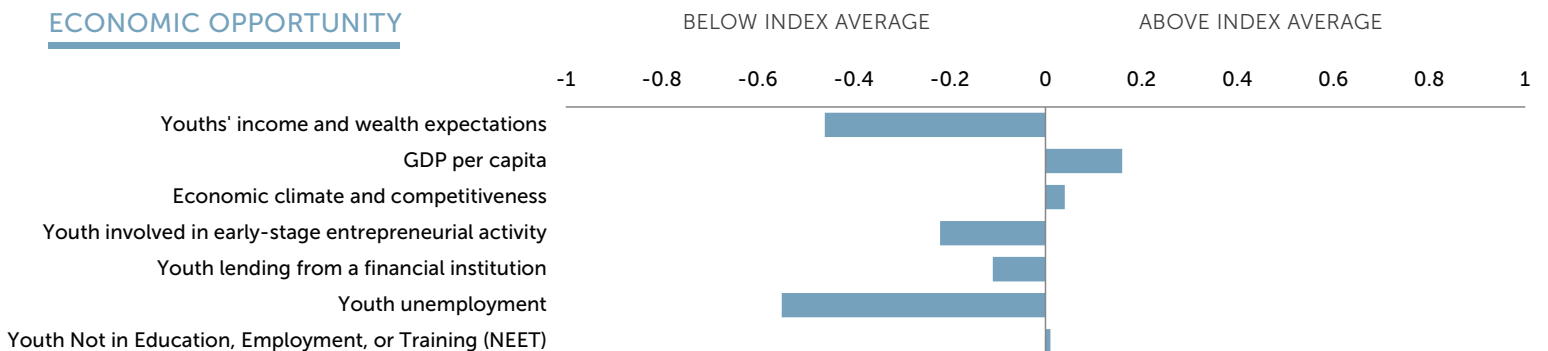

AT 8TH PLACE, SPAIN is third among the countries in the European region, eighth among the ten high income countries, and places at the top of the second of four tiers for youth wellbeing. Spain scores highest among the European countries in health and education, but youth indicate generally weak satisfaction and outlook in the citizen participation, safety and security, and economic opportunity domains.
