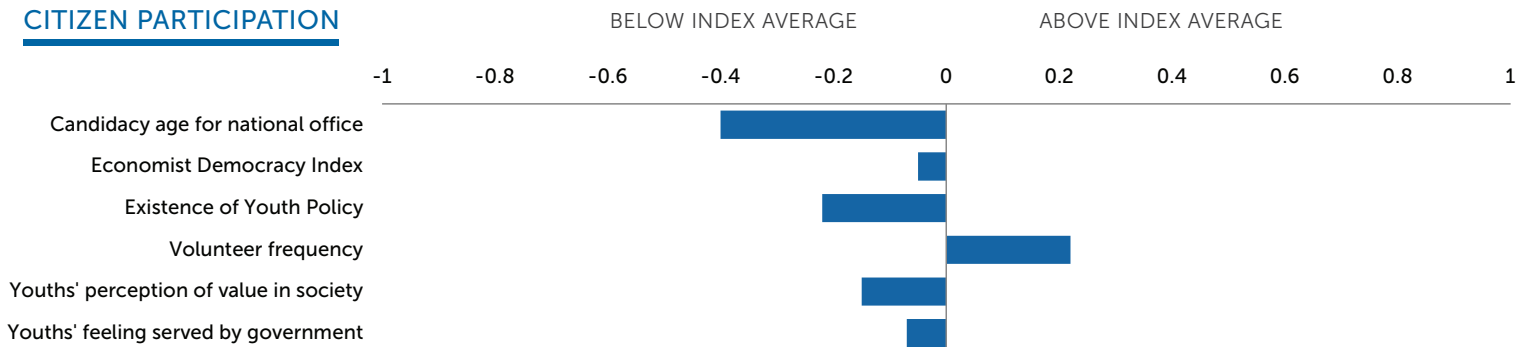

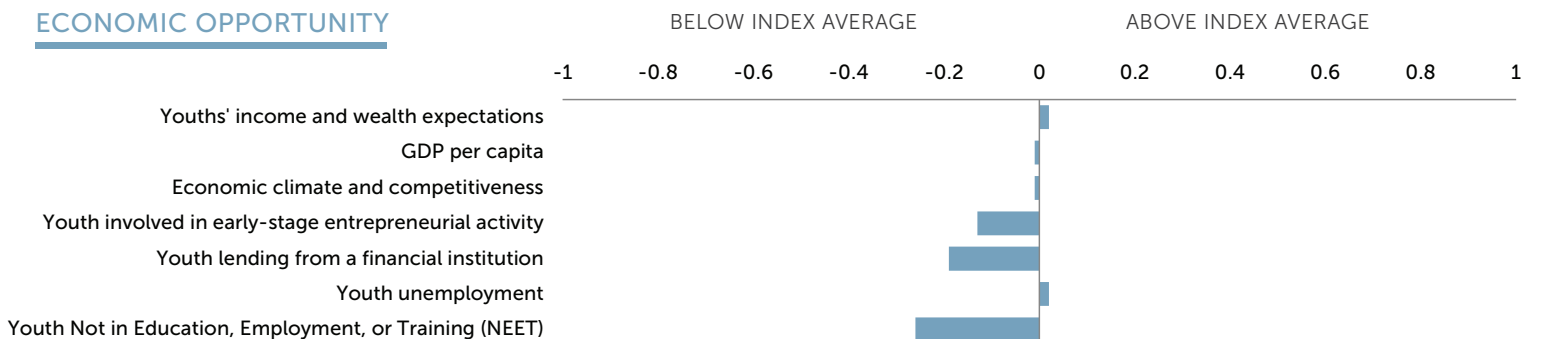
Upper Middle

AT 18TH PLACE, TURKEY places in the third of the four tiers of youth wellbeing. It also ranks fifth among the European countries, and eighth among the nine upper-middle income countries. With the exception of the safety and security domain, youth indicate generally weak satisfaction and outlook across the domains. This is particularly true in citizen participation, where youth feel less valued by society.
